You can use the following format:

1st **Paragraph**: This should provide a short summary of the book and include the title and author. (5-7 sentences)

2nd Paragraph: This should contain your opinion of the book. Did you like it? Why or why not? Give examples and evidence from the text to back up your opinion. (5-7 sentences)

3rd Paragraph: This should provide a recommendation. Who would you recommend this book to and why? (3-5 sentences)
