

Memorandum of Understanding for Applicant Parents

As a parent seeking to apply a student in a faithful Catholic school, I understand, affirm, and support the following:

1. Holy Spirit Preparatory School (Holy Spirit Prep or the School) is a distinctive religious community engaged in the formation of mind, body, heart and soul. Holy Spirit Prep is based on the Christian concept of the human person. We believe that children are created in the image and likeness of God with a supernatural destiny in Christ, since Christ has rescued them from the darkness of sin and called them to share in divine life, in communion with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
2. Our vision of the human person, therefore, is a vision of faith. It takes into account the wounds of original sin with which every human person is born. Yet our vision remains deeply positive because we believe Christ frees us from original sin and all other sin through baptism, and opens for us the gates of heaven. Viewed in this light, man emerges as being essentially open to hope.
3. This positive view of the created order gives rise to a series of fundamental educational principles, including the integral formation of every dimension of the human personality, including the intellect, will, passions, sentiments, emotions, imagination, values, and conscience.
4. Our Catholic identity, through fidelity to the moral teachings of the Church, is interwoven throughout the life of the School, and reflected in the School's policies and practices.
5. Holy Spirit Prep expects parents, guardians, and students to respect and not undermine the School's Catholic identity and mission. Thus, enrollment of a student is subject to the student and the student's parents/guardians complying with all School rules and requirements.
6. The ongoing support of the parents or guardians of the student for the School's mission and administration is critical to the School successfully fulfilling its mission and meeting the needs of its students. Continued enrollment at Holy Spirit Preparatory School is therefore subject to the maintenance of a positive and constructive relationship between the School and the parents/guardians.

As a parent/guardian desiring to enroll my child in Holy Spirit Prep, I accept this memorandum of understanding. If my child is enrolled in the School, I pledge support for the School's Catholic identity and mission, and I commit myself to uphold and conduct myself in accordance with all the principles and policies that govern the School for the duration of my child's tenure at the School.
