Course Information

Department: Humanities

Class Description: This course is a high-school level introduction to the Latin language. Using the Henle Latin, students will be introduced to the fundamental concepts of the ancient language-including noun declensions, verb conjugations, cases, tenses, adjective agreement, and syntax. They will learn all five declensions, as well as all four conjugations in both the active and passive voice, personal pronouns, and the subjunctive mood in the active voice. At the same time, they will learn about ancient Roman culture and the rich Christian patrimony of ecclesiastical Latin, studying various liturgical prayers and selections from the liturgy.
