


#### **Course Information**

Department: Humanities

**Class Description:** In this fifth year Latin language course, students will continue to develop advanced proficiency in Latin prose and poetry. Students will expand their mastery of Latin grammar, meter, and rhetorical devices by engaging important primary texts, including works from Vergil, Augustus, Ovid, Pliny, and Horace. Students will also be introduced to some works in Medieval Latin as well as Neo-Latin. At the same time, they will learn about ancient Roman history and culture and the geographical features of ancient Rome. Finally, this class will also note the rich, Christian patrimony of Latin in prayer and liturgy.

## **Summer Assignment**

### Learning objectives

- The student should be able to identify main characters of the *Aeneid* and have a thorough understanding of the plot (Books 1-12). (New Material)
- Master vocabulary (Latin to English as well as English to Latin) that will greatly facilitate our translation of Vergil's *Aeneid* (Books 1, 2, 4, and 6) (New Material).

### Estimate time of completion

- This will vary by student.

### Details of Assignment

Because we will be spending a significant amount of time translating sections from books 1, 2, 4, and 6 of the *Aeneid*, it is important that you are familiar with the entire book (Books 1-12) for proper context. Therefore, I am asking that you please read all of Vergil's *Aeneid* in translation. (I've attached a link to a modern, highly readable translation). **N.B. You will be tested on this reading on your first week back to school.**
